- Children must be between the ages of 10 and 17 for week one and 8 and 17 to participate in weeks 2, 3, and 4. All classes are taught in English only.
- Weekly sessions run five days per week. Partial weeks pay full week tuition (not pro-rated.) Full day sessions are from 9:00 am to 4:30 pm. Morning sessions run from 9:00 am to 12:30 pm; afternoon sessions from 1:00 pm to 4:30 pm. The week of July 10 to 14 is a full day mural workshop (no half-day registrations accepted.)
- Children who stay for the full day must bring lunch. The Museum provides light snacks only. Lunchtime is supervised, in the gated sculpture garden or classroom.
- FAM visual art classes are taught by FAM's staff of teaching artists and special guest artists.

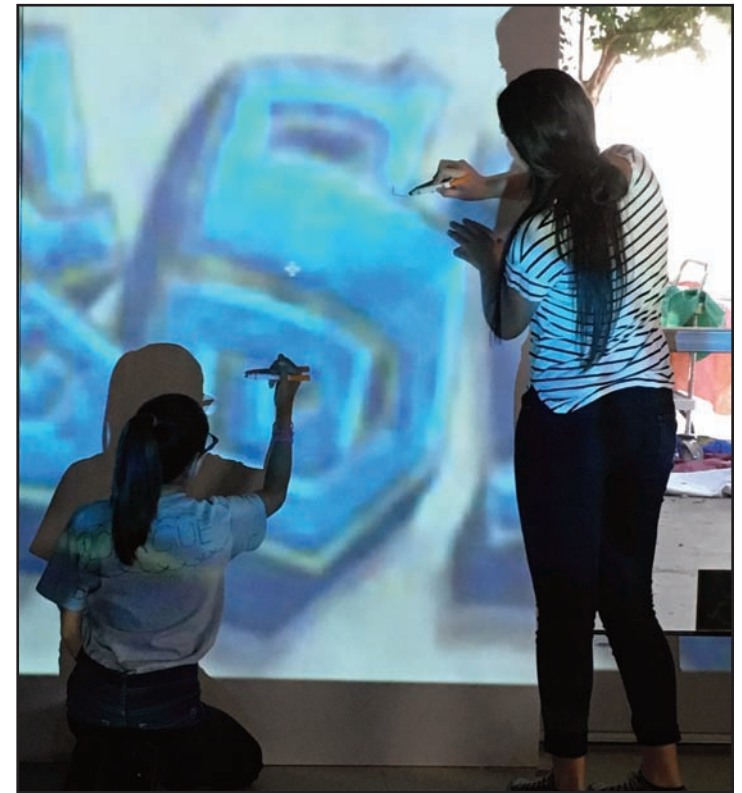

Students will explore the Elements of Art and how they apply to the Principles of Design through a variety of media in ALL of our workshops, including the performance art workshop. For ages 8 to 17 unless otherwise noted.

### Week 1 (July 10 to 14)

#### Mural Making Workshop - Art Brigade @FAM (FULL DAY only)

Eric Gonzalez, muralist, graffiti artist, educator, and founder of the Urbanists Collective in Visalia returns for another fun and inspiring session! Students in this workshop will create a semi-permanent outdoor wall mural in the Museum's Sculpture Garden inspired by images in FAM's Pre-Columbian Collection. The mural students will explore original works, contribute to the design, and help paint the mural with Erik's guidance. Note that students will use traditional brushwork and be trained on the proper use of spray paint in creating the mural. Be advised that most of the work takes place in a shady, gated area outside the classroom. **AGES 10 to 17 only.** Limited enrollment.

### Week 2 (July 17 to 21)

#### Assemblage (AM)

Students will be inspired by the multi-media works of Nancy Youdelman on display at FAM and will create unique works from a variety of materials not commonly thought of as art media.

#### Drawing & Painting (PM)

Students will explore our galleries and will create their own art by drawing with charcoal and oil pastels. They will have an opportunity to create their own unique acrylic painting.

### Week 3 (July 24 to 28)

#### Creatures Featured (AM)

Morning students will create artwork inspired by animals, including a modeling session with live animals. Students will utilize drawing, painting, and papier mache to create their own unique artworks of their favorite creatures.

#### Collage & Mosaic Construction (PM)

Afternoon students will explore patterns and the art of collage and learn how to do tile mosaics by creating a mosaic sphere.

### Week 4 (July 31 to August 4)

#### PopArt (AM)

Morning students will employ commonplace objects as subject matter to create fun art in the pop art style. They will be employing repeating images, graphic designs, and patterns with both printmaking and painting in the style of Warhol, Lichtenstein, Rauschenberg and others from this exciting era of art.

#### Art Outside the Box (Performance Art Workshop) (PM)

Taught by Katie Jenkins-Moses, who has a Masters degree in Studio Art with an emphasis in Performance Art, students will learn to change the way they think about making art. Join this performing arts class and experience one of the newer forms of fine art, and learn some traditional art techniques, too. Students will move, wiggle, and see what they can say with their bodies. This creative class is perfect for theatre students. They will learn what "performing art" means, act out some fun and memorable pieces, and create their own performances for an end-of-the-week celebratory show. "Be prepared to have fun, feel silly, be inspired, and think outside the box."
