

Faith Ringgold An American Artist

Wayne Thiebaud | 1958-1968

Bus will be departing from the VA Hospital at Clinton & Fresno Streets at 7:30 am and arriving in Sacramento around 11:00 am. The first part of the day will be spent at the Crocker Art Museum, where travelers can lunch at the Crocker Cafe (on your own) and view the Ringgold exhibition and other works in the Museum's permanent collection. At 2:30 pm, our bus will depart for the Manetti Shrem Museum on the UC Davis campus to see the Thiebaud exhibition, followed by a visit to downtown Davis for an early dinner (on your own) before returning to Fresno by approximately 10:30 pm.

At an extraordinary historical moment, Wayne Thiebauc proposed a radical new take on painting, and he did so with a slice of pie!

This exhibition at the new Manetti Shrem Museum at UC Davis, where Thiebaud is a professor emeritus, invites viewers to trace his emergence as a mature artist with a singular style. This is the first exhibition to explore this formative period. The exhibition brings together more than 60 early paintings gathered from private collections and museums throughout the United States.





Faith Ringgold | An American Artist

Best known for her story quilts, Faith Ringgold is also a painter, mixed-media sculptor, performance artist, activist, author, and teacher. This exhibition brings together more than 40 examples of Ringgold's varied production spanning four decades. It includes story quilts, tankas (inspired by Tibetan textile paintings called thangkas), prints, oil paintings, drawings, masks, soft sculptures, and original illustrations from the artist's award-winning book *Tar Beach*.
