WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS

Week 1 (July 11 to 15)

Printmaking/Bookmaking (AM) & Exploring Fiber Art (PM)

In the morning session, students will learn the art of design and printmaking, from simple stamping to printing on a press. They will have an opportunity to create a hand-bound book of prints to take home. In the afternoon, students will be inspired by the Fiber Art Master Works exhibition and create 2 and 3 dimensional works from fabric using a variety of techniques. AGES 8 TO 16.



Week 2 (July 18 to 22)

Drawing From Your Head (AM) & Comic Book **Design** (PM)

This workshop is taught by Andrea Ruiz, an illustrator and concept artist who has worked in feature film, TV, and games, most notably with LucasFilm Animation's Star Wars Detours and LucasArts' game Lucidity. It is recommended that students attend the entire day, but not required. Mornings will be spent honing drawing skills and the afternoon developing and illustrating a narrative, applying composition skills, using perspective, and learning to develop a memorable character to bring a story to life on paper. AGES 10 to 16 ONLY. Limited enrollment.



Week 3 (July 25 to 29)

Mural Making Workshop - Art Brigade @FAM (FULL DAY only)

Students in this workshop will create a mural inspired by the works of the late FranCisco Vargas, a local muralist. The completed mural will be displayed in the Fresno Art Museum's Concourse Gallery during the Fall 2016 Exhibition season, opening in September 2016. The mural students will explore the artist's work and conceive, design, and paint the mural under the guidance of Eric Gonzalez, muralist, graffiti artist, educator, and founder of the Urbanists

Collective in Visalia, California. Note that students will use traditional brushwork and be trained on the proper use of spray paint in creating the mural. AGES 8 TO 16. Limited enrollment.

Week 4 (August 1 to 5)

Drawing & Painting (AM) & Costume Creation (PM)

Morning students will explore drawing with charcoal, pencil, and oil pastels and will view and study original art in the Museum galleries. They will create their own unique acrylic painting. Afternoon students will explore creating costumes from repurposed items. This will be an opportunity to create their own unique costume for Halloween 2016. AGES 8 TO 16.
