No bags larger than 15" x 15" allowed—they may be left at front desk. Back-packs must be carried in front or left at front desk. No food or drinks (water bottles included) in the galleries—please leave at front desk. Children must be acompanied to the restrooms.

MOST IMPORTANT! Help us protect our delicate artworks by reminding the children not to touch or lean on the walls, the pedestals, or the artwork. And absolutely, NO running in the galleries.

We appreciate you taking the time to assist the teacher and our Museum staff in making the visit for ALL the students the best art museum experience possible!

Here are some tips to help make the field trip a success:

- 1. Set an example for the children by following all the rules yourself.
- 2. Be sure to NOT block children's view of the art instructor or the art during the tour.
- 3. Please refrain from conversations with other adults during the tour—they are distracting for both the children and the art instructors.
- 4. Stay with your group during the tour and engage with ALL the students, not just your own.
- 5. Make the Museum an electronics-free zone (except for non-flash photography.) Phone calls must be taken away from the tour group or outside in the garden.
- 6. We love to have adults actively participate on tours, but remember that the students' questions come first. Be sure to let them answer questions posed to them before jumping in.
- 7. If you notice children distracting each other, help them stay focused by quietly separating them. Discourage off-subject conversations between the children.
- 8. Best "home" for hands is behind the back.
