

Color Theory Supply List (Weeks 4 and 7)

Check to see if you already have some of these supplies before purchasing. For specific examples for those things listed with an asterisk, you can find them on an Amazon List at <https://a.co/8DYVtKC>. It is highly recommended that you purchase each item (or the equivalent) before the start of class if you do not already have access to them. You only need one of each unless otherwise stated. In some cases, we found that some of the items come in multiple packs on Amazon at a lower price than buying individually. Some things you can find at Dollar Tree, Allard's Art, GSW School Supply, Michael's, Office Depot or other stores at a lower price than on Amazon.

- All media sketchbook, 9" x 12" * or multiple sheets of thick paper or board that can handle wet media *
- Acrylic paint (red, blue, yellow, black, and white)*
- A selection of brushes *
- Twin Tip Permanent Markers, Fine and Ultra Fine, Black *
- Color markers (broad) *
- Crayons *
- Pencils/eraser(standard, 2B) and sharpener*

Household items you may already have:

- Small water spritzer bottle (to keep acrylics from drying out when on your palette) – you can find them in travel section of most drug stores or at Dollar Tree
- Paper towels
- Palette (a white plastic plate or vegetable or meat tray will work)
- Apron or old t-shirt to protect clothes
- Old newspaper to cover work surface
- Water jar (any wide-mouth, empty 5" or 6" high container will work)
- Water access to clean brushes
