Stop-Motion Animation Supplies Needed

Check to see if you already have some of these supplies before purchasing. For specific examples for those things listed with an asterisk, you can find them on an Amazon List at https://a.co/iXCogbJ. It is highly recommended that you purchase each item (or the equivalent) before the start of class if you do not already have access to them. You only need one of each unless otherwise stated. In some cases, we found that some of the items come in multiple packs on Amazon at a lower price than buying individually. Some things you can find at Dollar Tree, Allard's Art, GSW School Supply, Michael's, Office Depot or other stores at a lower price than on Amazon.

- Smartphone to record single photos (not video) or digital camera and computer (however, Smartphone is preferred)
- Smartphone tripod* or tripod for phone/camera if you will be using a digital camera
 - The tripod needs to be able to film facing the ground
 - Or DIY a tripod (using a full-sized paper cup, and then a cardboard box)

- 10" x 12" construction paper- multi-colors*
- Scissors*
- Glue stick *
